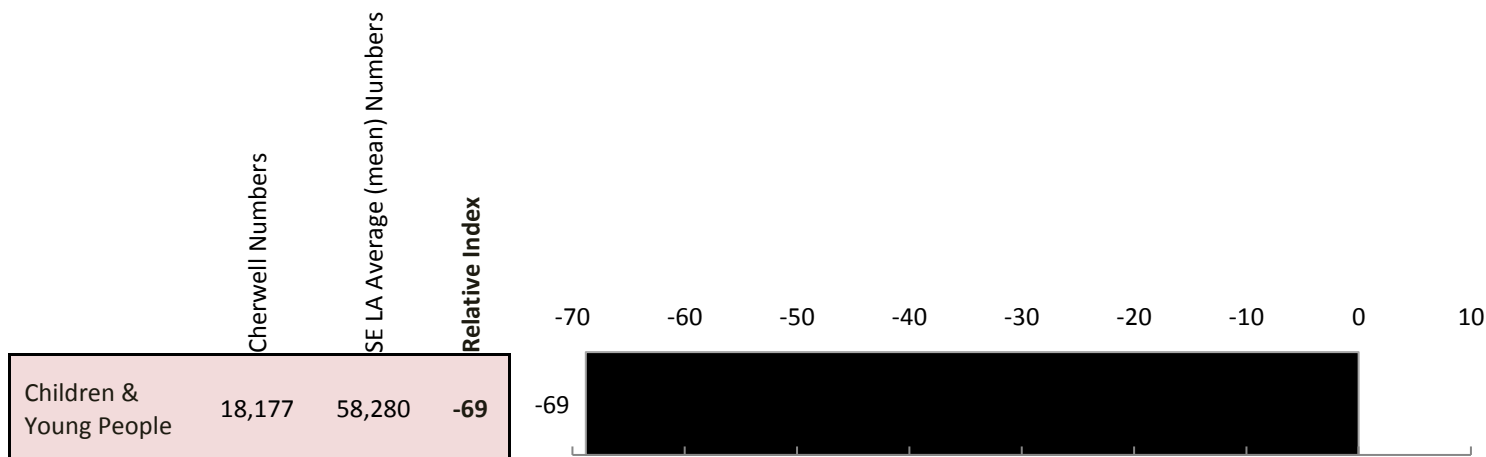

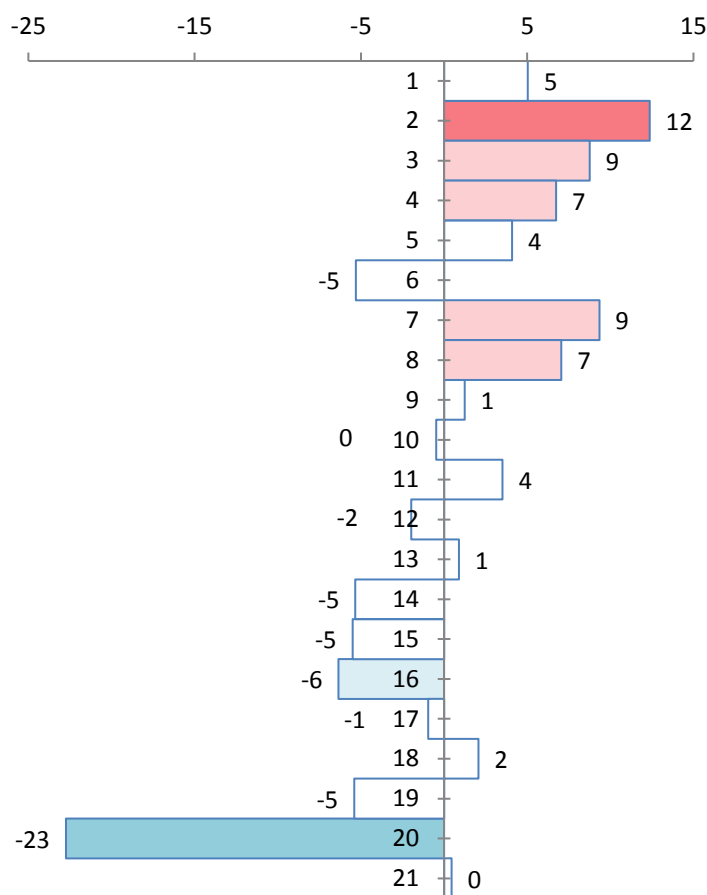
3. INDICATOR #1: CYP POPULATION – PUPIL & STUDENT NUMBERS

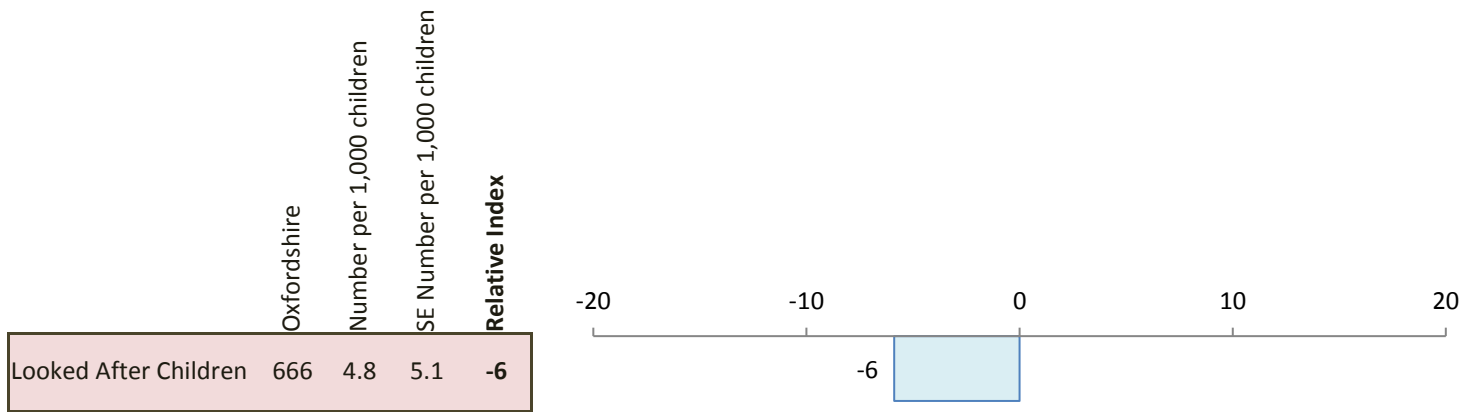

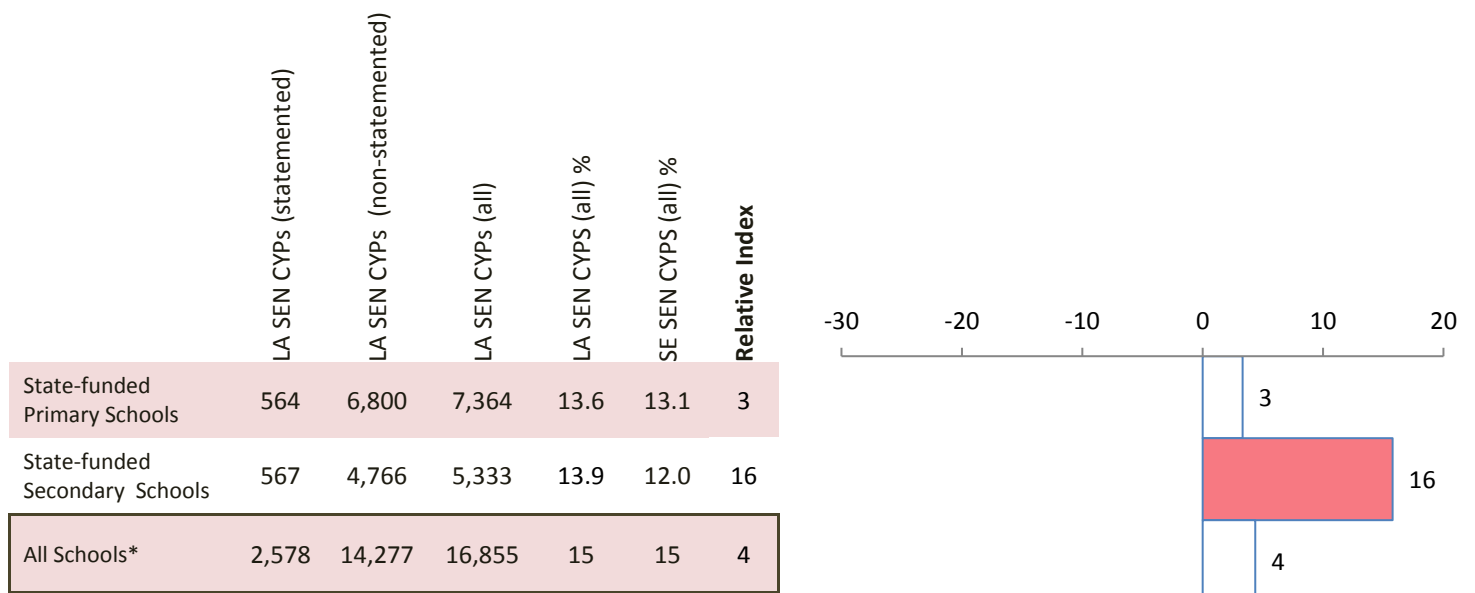

6. INDICATOR #4: CYP POPULATION – OXFORDSHIRE SEN CHILDREN (ALL TYPES < 19 years old)



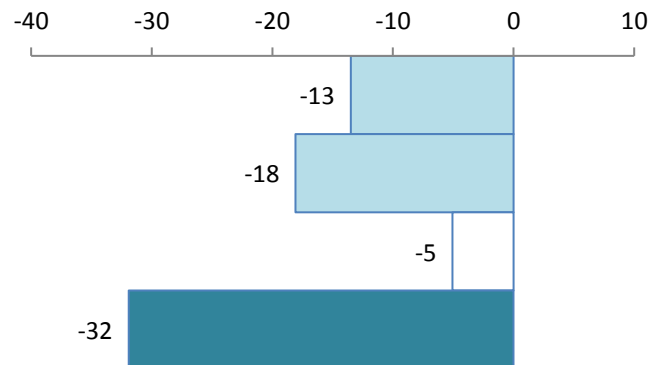

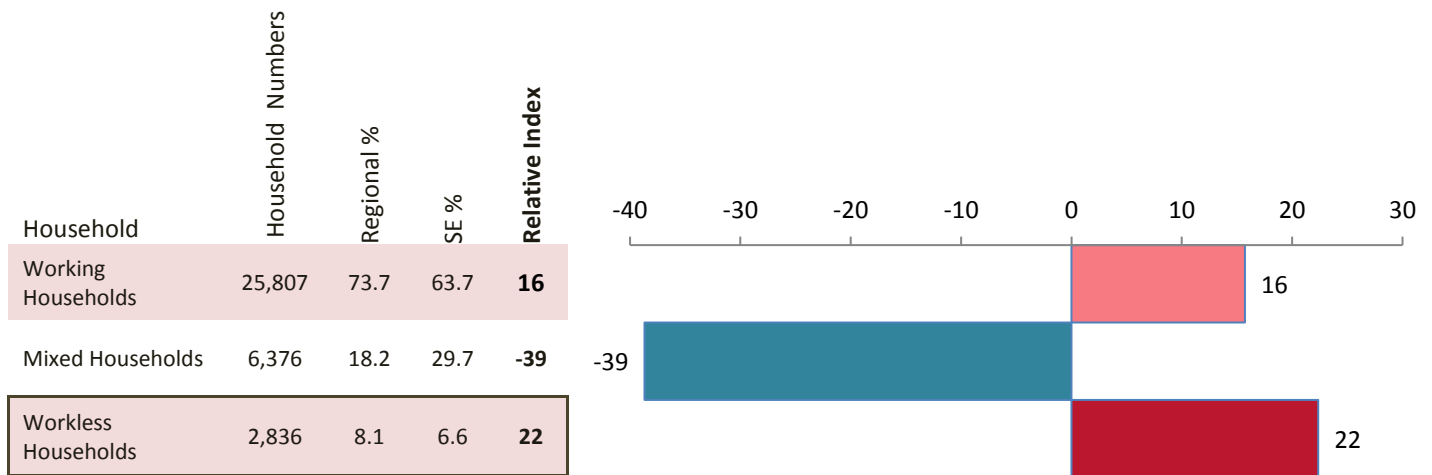

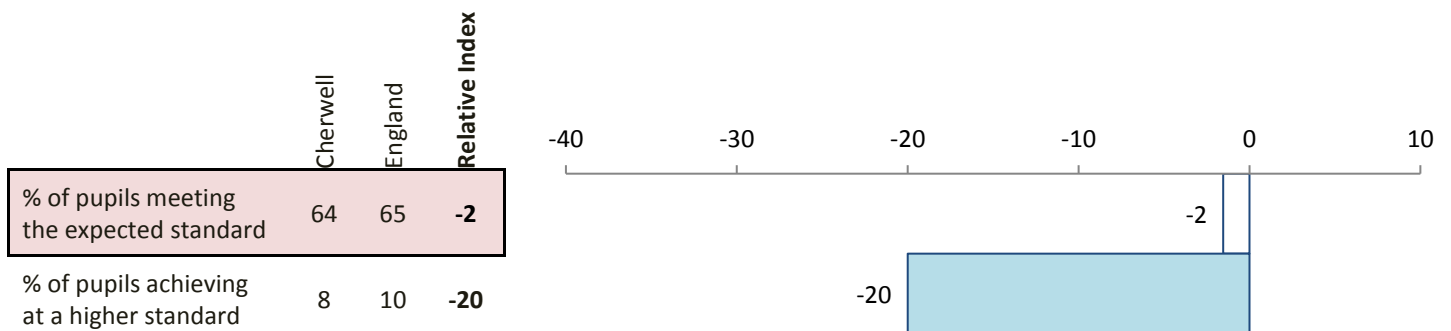

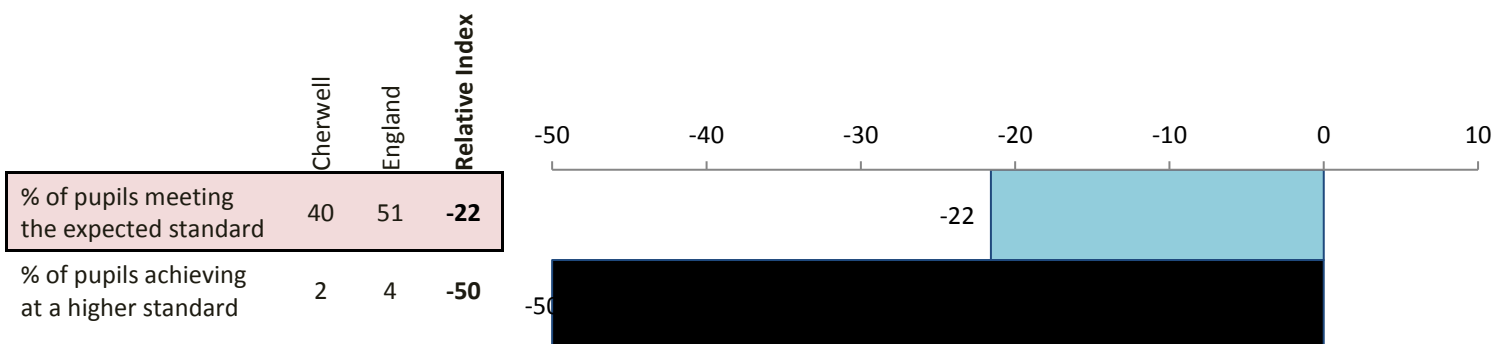

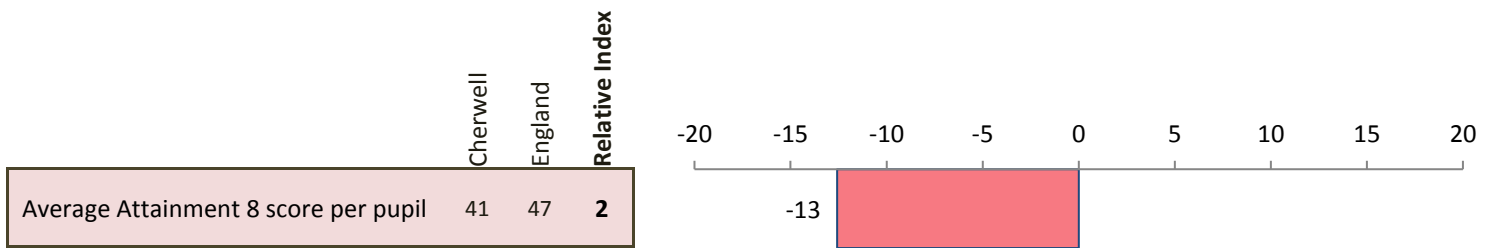

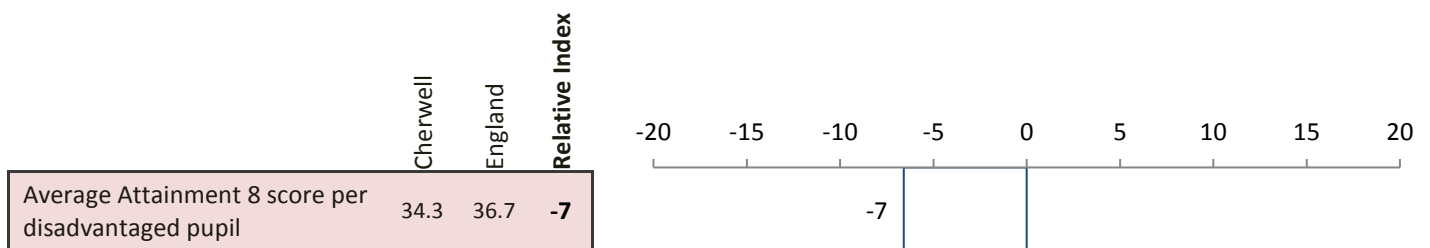
