1 ARTICLE 5

Everyone has the right to liberty and security of person

"Liberty cannot be denied except in accordance with the law"



2 ARTICLE 9

Freedom of thought, conscience, belief and religion and to change and express your beliefs

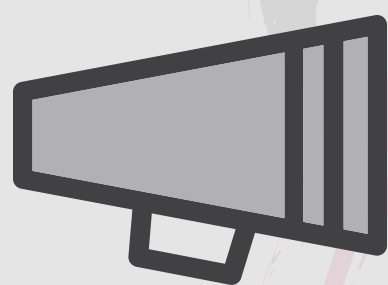
"Respect for different opinions"



3 ARTICLE 10

Freedom of expression of your opinions without government interference and to receive information that enables you to form an opinion

"Protest without prosecution"



4 ARTICLE 8

Respect for your private and family life, home and correspondence without government or media interference

"The right to live privately"

"Equality of rights and responsibilities"

2 A COUNTRY WHERE PEOPLE CHOOSE THEIR GOVERNMENT AND ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES

"Rule by the people, for the people"



3 VOICING YOUR IDEAS, OPINIONS AND QUESTIONS, RESPECTING THE VIEWS AND DIFFERENCES OF OTHERS, REACHING COMPROMISE AND AGREEMENT

"Participate in debate, difference and decision-making"



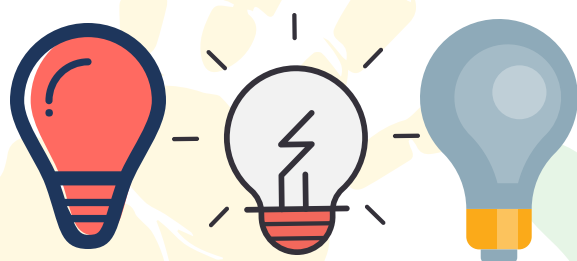

- 3 Taking time to appreciate and understand the beliefs, values and ideas of others and sharing your own**

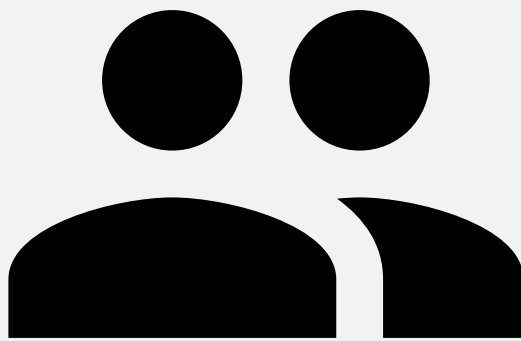


- 4 Accepting difference, creating harmony through non-judgement of peoples' faiths and beliefs**

THE RULE OF LAW

1 ACCOUNTABLE

Citizens and Governments (lawmakers) are equally accountable under the law
“No one is above the law”



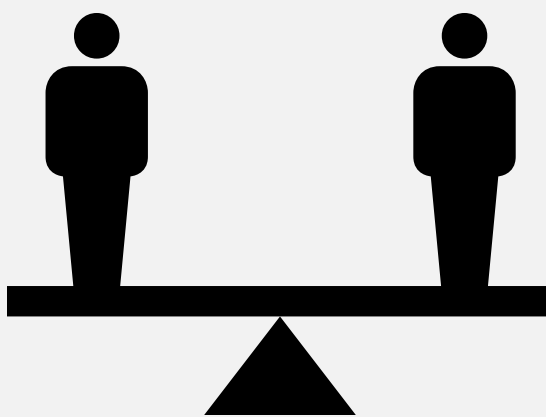
2 JUST

Laws are clear, publicised, stable, and applied evenly. They protect rights – security / property / human
“Legal certainty”



3 OPEN

The process by which a law is enacted, administered and enforced is accessible, fair and efficient
“The law is always applied evenly”



4 ACCESSIBLE AND IMPARTIAL

Justice is timely, delivered by competent, ethical, independent representatives that are accessible, adequately resourced, and reflect the make-up of the communities they serve
“Equality before the law”
